# Waiver and Release of Liability

For Participation in any Mach One SRS Team, USA Canoe/Kayak, American Canoe Association, Inc., and AAU Junior Olympic athletic/sports program and related events and activities, the undersigned, for him/herself, his/her personal representatives, heirs, next of kin:

1. Agrees (with parents if a minor) that prior to participating, he/she will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used & if he/she believes anything is unsafe, will immediately advise his/her coach or supervisor of such condition(s) & refuse to participate.
2. Acknowledges and fully understands that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses to person or property which might result not only from his/her own actions, inactions, or negligence, but also the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of play, or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, that there may be other risks not known to us or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
3. Assumes all the foregoing risks and accepts personal responsibility for any and all loss, liability, damages, or costs following such injury, permanent disability, and death.
4. Releases, waives, discharges, and covenants not to sue the Mach One SRS Team, USA Canoe/Kayak, and American Canoe Association, Inc., its affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches, and other employees, or agents of the organization, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event, all of which are hereinafter referred to as "releasees", from any and all claims, liability, demands, losses, or damages on account of injury, including death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in the whole or part by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise.
5. Agree(s) to indemnify and save and hold harmless the releasees from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in any way competing, officiating, observing, or working for, or for any other purpose participating in the event.

One of 4 Regional Slalom races for Juniors and Cadets for \$\$\$ paddling  
Two top juniors and two top Junior-16 get \$200; top Cadet and top Cub Cadet get \$200.*

**Saturday, April 27, 2013** Free training as soon as course is set up  
Late registration Noon – 4 p.m.

**Sunday, April 28, 2013** Course closed; Pre-race meeting, bib pick-up 9 a.m.  
FIRST BOAT OFF AT 10:00 a.m. (back-to-back runs)

## Registration deadline:

Mail completed entry by April 22 or send an e-mail with PDF fill-in entry attached by April 26 to d1k@psu.edu. When sending a PDF, print a completed copy, and report to registration upon arrival at the site to complete payment. Entry includes T-shirt while supply lasts.

**Entry Fees:** Adults and Juniors: \$20 for 1st class, 2nd class \$10. Cadets and Cub Cadets: \$15 for 1st class; 2nd class \$5. There is a two-class limit for all groups.

**Classes:** K1, K1W, C1, C1W, C2, C2 Mixed, C2W, race boats, recreational boats (plastic), and open boats. Classes will be grouped as necessary with three boats needed for awards. Cadet and Junior age group classes will not be grouped. All ages welcome.

**Requirements:** All paddlers *must* wear a helmet and a PFD. Boats are expected to have legal, blunt ends. This is a USACK sanctioned race; membership card or \$10 event fee required *with* signed USACK waiver.

**Course:** 15–20 gate course, appropriate for beginning and intermediate paddlers.

**Lodging:** Super 8, Lewistown, PA 1-800-889-9698. Home stays available on a first come, first serve basis. Contact Michelle Van Horn at 814-355-9286 for home stay availability/arrangements.

**Location Directions:** Kishacoquillas Narrows from Lewistown and Yeagertown/Reedsville, PA.

**From the west:** From State College area going east on Rt. 322 take the Reedsville/Bellefonte exit Route 655. Turn left at exit ramp towards Reedsville following North Main through Reedsville south 1.8 miles to the course in the mountain gap. Park at the Fay Wagner Tire Store or do a “U” turn from the Wagner parking area onto Railroad Avenue down to the course.

**From the east:** Take the Burnham exit approx. 3 miles past Lewistown, a left at the end of the exit ramp towards Burnham. Go about 0.5 mile to stoplight and then left (at Burger King) for maybe 2 miles through Yeagertown. You are in a mountain gap. In leaving Yeagertown look for the Fay Wagner Tire Store. Parking there or down Railroad Avenue to the right.

**Parking:** Parking will be available along the highway at Fay Wagner Tire Store.

**Food:** No concession will be available. Bring your own.

**Camping:** Available on-site. A Porta John will be available during the weekend.
